Ensure every student is succeeding at Gunalda State School:

 Students with disabilitys can access and fully participate in learning, alongside their similar-aged peers, supported by reasonable adjustments and teaching strategies tailored to meet their individual needs.

Ensure 85% of students achieve a 'C' or greater in English. This will be possible through systematic curriculum delivery, effective pedagogical pactice and an expert teaching teams to;

- Develop a deep understanding of the Australian Curriculum and how writing is used across all learning areas
- Improve students' literacy achievement through developing a writing program
- Create a systematic approach to collaborative inquiry-based professional learning, coaching, observation and feedback, to improve teaching practices in writing.

Our initiatives include

- 1. Employing a specialty trained teacher aide to support students with disabilities to fully participate in learning alongside their similar age peers in an inclusive framework.
- 2. Purchasing Teacher Relief Scheme (TRS) to allow:
 - a. Staff to attend specific professional development in writing
 - b. Staff to be released to engage in a collegial observation, coaching and feedback model within the school and across cluster schools.
